



## GEORGIA VOTING SYSTEM RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Our State Representatives and Senators took an oath of office to support the Constitution of the State of Georgia. In Article II, Section 1, Paragraph 1 it states that "Elections by the people shall be by secret ballot and shall be conducted in accordance with procedures provided by law."

WHEREAS, to have a legitimate, trustworthy and Constitutional electoral process, Georgians must be able to determine the root causes of known problems identified in the November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 and January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, May 24, 2022 elections so that solutions can be implemented in time for the 2024 elections;

WHEREAS, Georgia's Dominion voting system is unverifiable to the voter because it accumulates votes hidden in [Quick Response \(QR\) codes](#) that the voter cannot read or verify to ensure they match the printed text;

WHEREAS, a U.S. District Court [order](#) found Georgia's Dominion voting system violates Georgia election code that requires the system to produce an elector verifiable ballot [Pg. 81, 82];

WHEREAS, the same U.S. District Court found Georgia's Dominion voting system violates Georgia election code that requires a voting system to "...produce paper ballots which are marked with the elector's choices in a format readable by the elector";

WHEREAS, Georgia's Dominion voting system tabulators malfunctioned in multiple counties during the November 2020 election and thus impacted thousands of votes cast;

WHEREAS, Georgia's Dominion voting system declared the wrong winners in the DeKalb County Commission District 2 race in the May 24, 2022 primary;

WHEREAS, a hand count audit revealed that Georgia's Dominion voting system shorted a District 2 commission candidate over 3,000 votes in the DeKalb County Commission District 2 race in the May 24, 2022 primary;

WHEREAS, a hand count audit revealed that Georgia's Dominion voting system gave over 1,400 unearned votes to a DeKalb County Commission District 2 candidate in the May 24, 2022 primary;

WHEREAS, a hand count audit revealed that Georgia's Dominion voting system failed to count over 1,800 votes cast in the DeKalb County Commission District 2 race in the May 24, 2022 primary;

WHEREAS, Georgia's Dominion voting system failure to count over 1,800 votes cast in the DeKalb County Commission District 2 race in the May 24, 2022 primary represents a failure to count over 11% of the votes cast in that race;

WHEREAS, the only reason that the DeKalb County Commission District 2 tabulation malfunction was detected because a candidate received zero votes in the precinct where she and her husband lived and voted;

WHEREAS, the only reason that the DeKalb County Commission District 2 hand count audit was ordered because the Dominion voting system produced similar inaccurate results during a machine recount;

WHEREAS, the DeKalb County District 2 Commission race is the only candidate race that was fully audited in the statewide May 24, 2022 primary

WHEREAS, the Dominion Voting System has a 0% accuracy rate in fully audited May 24, 2022 candidate races;

WHEREAS, the Dominion voting system has never been forensically evaluated after any of its malfunctions;

WHEREAS, parts or all of the same Dominion voting system that Georgia uses was [rejected in Texas](#) and [banned in Colorado](#) before the Georgia Secretary of State purchased it;

WHEREAS, VoterGA evidence presented to Georgia General Assembly members indicates that Dominion voting system ballot images used to produce the 2020 Fulton Co. election results were electronically altered prior to certification;

WHEREAS, VoterGA evidence presented to Georgia General Assembly members indicates that Dominion voting system awarded 17,324 more in-person votes than what Fulton Co. has in-person ballot images to support;



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WHEREAS, four senior poll managers and two audit monitors submitted [sworn affidavits](#) under penalty of perjury stating they saw counterfeit ballots in the Fulton County hand count audit conducted on November 14<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> 2020;

WHEREAS, GEO tracking evidence and video recordings of ballot traffickers showed that there were up to 242 or more ballot traffickers who may have placed counterfeit ballots into unsecure drop boxes in the 2020 General Election;

WHEREAS, the Dominion voting system failed to detect any counterfeit ballots in the November 2020 election;

WHEREAS, unjust, falsely conceived, [orders](#) to dismiss the Fulton Co. ballot inspection case left Georgia voters with no recourse to legally protect their voting rights against ballot box stuffing for over two years;

WHEREAS, despite the Georgia Supreme Court overturning of said lower court rulings, 2020 Fulton Co. mail-in ballots have still not been publicly inspected for counterfeits which may number into tens of thousands according to at least one affidavit;

WHEREAS, [massive errors and fraud](#) were found in the Fulton Co. Presidential race audit including a 60% batch error rate, falsified tally sheets and thousands of duplicate votes reported in the audit;

WHEREAS, the errors and fraud found in the audit make it impossible for the November 2020 Presidential race audit results to have been used to verify the published election results;

WHEREAS, a U.S. District Court [order](#) found that the office of the Secretary of State is “not credible”;

WHEREAS, dozens of Georgia counties illegally destroyed over 1.7 million original ballot images and other election records for the November 2020 election, making it impossible to use those images to audit county election results;

BE IT RESOLVED, that we the undersigned demand our legislators and county officials to take action to alleviate Georgia voters from the burden of voting on an illegal, unverifiable voting system

BE IT RESOLVED, that we the undersigned demand our legislators and county officials to return Georgia voters to a system that hand counts hand marked paper ballots to restore public trust in Georgia elections;
